

Transitional By-law: If the proposed new by-laws are adopted by the congregation, Section III relating to the election of committee members shall be temporarily modified so that any member currently serving on a board or a committee whose term has not expired may continue to serve on that committee (or its successor) until his or her current term expires if he or she wishes; regardless of the fact that the committee may temporarily have more members than called for by the new by-laws.

However, the time previously served on that board or committee shall be counted toward the 6 year time limitation for serving on a committee. This transitional by-law will be automatically null and void on June 30, 2011.

Explanatory note: Members currently serving on a board or a committee may continue to serve until their current term expires. Since the terms of all existing boards and committees are 3 years, all current terms will expire June 30, 2011.
